Lands zoned for industrial, business or employment uses are essential to meet the service and jobs needs for our growing community. Identifying the issues, opportunities and challenges around employment land uses will provide strategic direction for the future.



## COUNCIL'S EMPLOYMENT LAND USE STUDY:

Identifies the key economic and employment issues and trends affecting the Hornsby Shire including:

- Few employed residents work locally (only 28%)
- Low employment growth (only 2% in 10 years to 2016)
- Additional industrial land required to meet future demand
- Commercial land needs to be protected.



Provides a strategic framework for supporting sustainable growth that will meet Council's employment targets set by the State Government.



Informs future refinements to the Hornsby Local Strategic Planning Statement.
