## HERITAGE ACTION PLAN

Our local heritage includes items of built, natural, cultural and Aboriginal significance. They give us a glimpse into Hornsby's rich and diverse past and should be enjoyed by all of our community.



Council will be undertaking a Comprehensive Heritage Study to ensure we continue to look after and celebrate our heritage. To inform the study, a review of our current heritage processes and management against best practice has been undertaken and we want your feedback on the Action Plan.

## **FINDINGS**

The best practice review and Action Plan acknowledges Council's proven commitment to the conservation of natural and cultural heritage. The review identifies that the heritage measures established by Council in 1993 are essential foundations for best practice heritage management. However, additional initiatives and updates are required to respond to the changing development context, demography and community expectations including:

- 1. Updated history of Hornsby reflecting the course and pattern of development over time
- 2. Revised Aboriginal Heritage Study
- 3. New archaeological and landscape heritage study and
- 4. Additional community engagement and promotion of heritage.

Upfront engagement and ownership by the community and promotion of the Action Plan is important, especially as part of the 20-year vision for growth for the Shire.
